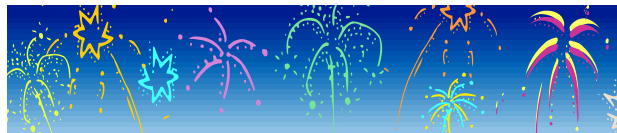

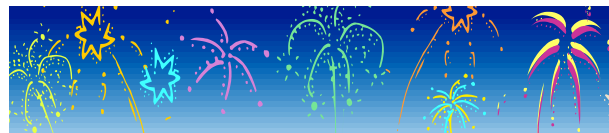
Certificate for Occupational Safety Managers (COSM)
