


Coronavirus Protection



A residential roofing contractor faces \$240,880 in penalties for exposing workers to safety hazards at two worksites.

A rail car tank cleaning and repair facility was fined \$371,276 for safety and health hazards.




Fall Violations

A cookie manufacturer was fined \$221,257 for exposing workers to falls and other hazards.
