FIRST AID / BBP

You may have the chance to make the difference for someone between life and death, rapid recovery, long hospitalization or temporary disability and permanent injury.

Program participants learn to recognize the signs and symptoms of injuries and sudden illness, as well as how to respond to them.

Crucial information about how to deal with emergencies like shock, burns, stings, strains, strokes, seizures, and opioid overdose is shared. They will learn what to do in the case of an airway obstruction or choking.

Basic First Aid Certification is valid for two years.
Bloodborne Pathogen Certification is valid for one year.



CPR / AED

Students master necessary skills for the administration of CPR. They learn how to recognize a life-threatening emergency, how to provide basic life support and what to do in the case of Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA)

The Health & Safety Institute (HSI) CPR programs are based on the most current science and guidelines for Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation and are consistent with other national CPR programs.

These nationally accepted programs were reviewed by and meet the guidelines of the Occupational Safety & Health Administration and the Department of Transportation.
