Safety Tip for **Driving Courteously**

In Northwest Ohio, let's all apply the 11 Tips for being a "Courteous Driver," whenever we are on the roadway . . .

- 1. Always use your blinker... Rule of Thumb is 100 feet before turning.
- 2. Share the road.
- Focus on the road... Don't drive distracted!
- 4. Drive in the right or middle lane and pass on the left.
- 5. Respect pedestrians and cyclists.
- 6. Don't block intersections or cross-walks.
- 7. Come to a complete stop at STOP signs, then look both ways before proceeding.
- 8. Slow down at yellow lights.
- 9. Maintain a safe distance... Rule of Thumb 3-4 seconds of space between.
- 10. Drive the speed limit or go with the "flow of the traffic."
- 11. When a vehicle needs to merge, don't cut them off, let them in.
