

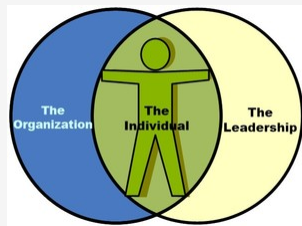


Congratulations!!!!
